A. Licensing and Operational Compliance

- Supporting the Manager of Regulatory Affairs in ensuring that MEASAT Satellite Systems Sdn. Bhd. (MSS) possess valid operating licenses/permits and MSS maintains ongoing compliance with existing regulatory legislation;
- Performing research on regulatory framework of Malaysian and foreign jurisdictions, monitoring changes in law and policy arising, maintain and regularly update MSS database and checklists on Local Regulatory Compliance and Foreign Regulatory Satellite Access (for landing Rights and Licenses/Permits);
- Review, advise, assist, coordinate, track and undertake all matters incidental to ensure MSS compliance with all license/permit conditions, laws, regulations, notifications, determinations, codes, guidelines and policy matters;
- Monitoring and ensuring timely renewals of all Apparatus Assignments (AAs) and other licenses issued to MSS by MCMC;
- Ensuring implementation of directives/notices from Government across operational business units;
- Attend to reporting requirements if the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) e.g Return of Net Revenue (RONR) submission pursuant to Universal Service Provision (USP) Regulations, Determination on Mandatory Standards and Access Reference Documents (ARDS); and
- Assist with preparation of letters, replies and submissions relevant to queries and official correspondence from Government(s) and/or regulatory authorities.

B. Corporate Strategy

- Handle regulatory aspects to support overall corporate strategy objectives and projects;
- Provide specialist advice on Malaysian regulatory framework and local sensitivities;
- Assisting in lobbying activities to ensure MSS interests are represented and protected in changing environment;
- Track trends in satellite regulations in global markets impacting operations and interests of MSS business units;
- Ensuring MSS is represented at relevant Government/Regulatory/Industry meetings and ensuring MSS interest is protected;
- Attend relevant internal business units meetings relevant to the functions of the department.
