MEASAT AND IR&AC REACH AGREEMENT

Kuala Lumpur, 25 May 2010 – MEASAT Satellite Systems Sdn. Bhd. (“MEASAT”) announced today it had reached agreement with the International Relations and Accounting Centre (“IR&AC”) of the Ministry of Communications and Information Technologies of the Republic of Azerbaijan. The agreement provides a framework for the joint development of the 46.0°E orbital slot.

MEASAT currently operates the AFRICASAT-1 satellite at 46.0°E. The satellite provides inclined orbit C and Ku-Band satellite capacity into the African, European and Central Asian regions.
