



# The MEASAT-3 Launch Competition Win a trip to witness the launch of M-3 satellite in Kazakhstan!

**Kuala Lumpur, 22 September 2006** – Astro Ceria and MEASAT Satellite Systems Sdn. Bhd. announced today the start of a competition for Malaysian school students in conjunction with the launch of the MEASAT-3 satellite, the country's third communication satellite, at the end of the year.

The organizers welcome entries from primary schoolchildren (ages 7-12) and secondary school students (ages 13 - 17) with a drawing of the MEASAT-3 communication satellite and a 100-word description either in Bahasa Melayu or English. First prize winners of both the primary and secondary categories will win a fully-paid trip for themselves and a guardian to the Baikonur Cosmodrome in Kazakhstan to witness the launch of MEASAT-3. The cosmodrome, which today hosts the launch pad of the Proton Breeze M rocket, is the historic location from which the Vostok-1 rocket carrying Yuri Gagarin, the first man in space, was launched. Six (6) runners up from each category and their guardians will be invited to the MEASAT-3 launch event celebrations in Kuala Lumpur where guests will watch a live broadcast of the satellite launch. A list of other prizes to be presented to the winners and runners-up is attached.

MEASAT-3 drawings should be made on ordinary art block paper, using watercolours, poster colours or crayons. The 100-word description should be written on a separate piece of A4 paper, which is then glued to the back of the drawing. The description must be signed by a parent or guardian to confirm that the drawing was solely the student's own work. All non-returnable entries should be mailed to:

Entries should reach the organizers no later than **10 October 2006**. All submissions must include the participants' and guardian's names, birth date, copy of their birth certificate or MyKad number, addresses and telephone numbers. Those contestants wishing to be considered for the first prize in each category must possess a valid passport on the 10<sup>th</sup> October 2006 with at least 12 months validity. A photocopy of the information page in their passports should be attached to the entry.

The results of the competitions will be announced through the mass media no later than 15 October 2006.
