

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

In general, to support the General Counsel in all regulatory and compliance matters.

Specifically, but not limited to:

- provide leadership and advice on all regulatory and compliance matters
- be the main contact person responsible for all regulatory and government interactions (both local and foreign) to enhance company profile and position and to ensure that company interests are well represented and protected, at all times; and
- provide leadership, support and guidance to the regulatory team

REPRESENTATIVE ACTIVITIES

1. Licensing, Compliance and Access (Local and International Regulatory):

- Responsible to obtain and/or maintain Company operating licenses / permits / apparatus assignments and applicable approvals to conduct its business both in and outside Malaysia (if necessary);
- Support the HOD / Manager in obtaining clearances required for satellite operations in targeted jurisdictions and the necessary regulatory approvals e.g. landing rights and local licenses;
- Monitoring compliance of all applicable regulatory laws and regulation (including Company's Foreign & Local Regulatory Checklist) including monitoring and reporting;

Government Relations:

- Build a solid and sustainable working relationship with the government, regulators, governmental and regulatory agencies both local and foreign;
- Coordinate formal submissions and lobbying activities with the relevant regulatory and/or governmental authorities to support and protect Company interests
- In addition, to represent Company in any other international regulatory or governmental forums including APT and ITU, in particular to contribute, champion and/or defend policy issues relating to the satellite industry.

3. Strategy and Industry Development:

- Responsible for the overall corporate objectives
- Monitor and advise Company of any changes in trends, law and policy concerning satellite regulation;
- Provide specialist advice on Malaysian regulatory frameworks and sensitivities with the objective to support overall corporate objectives;
- Contributing in forums, conferences and other activities to ensure Company's interests are represented in particular policy matters and/or regulations that affect the satellite and/or telecommunication industry or Company's interest.

4. Leadership, support and guidance to the regulatory team

- Guide and supervise all personnel in the regulatory department on day to day operations; provide development path for subordinates

- Degree in Law, Engineering, Management Sciences, or Business Administration.
- At least 8 years of relevant experience in telecommunication industry with solid understanding of the Malaysian regulatory frameworks.
